FOURTH OF JULY PET SAFETY TIPS



- Make sure pets are microchipped and have current collar tags!
- 2. Exercise early in the day!
- Feed before the fireworks display and keep high value treat or toys on hand as distractions from flashes and noise.
- Keep pets inside and prepare a quiet, dark space in your home. Play TV or music to drown out loud noises.
- Talk with your vet about alternative treatments if your pet's anxiety is severe.




