Dear Friends,

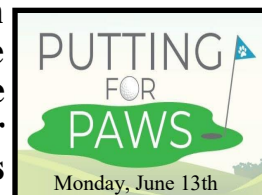

The MAGIC Fund is used to cover the many medical costs that arise at the sanctuary. New arrivals require vaccinations and spay/neuter surgeries. All of the 200 animals receive monthly heart worm and flea preventative. Many animals develop orthopedic or other health problems that require surgery. Hallie Hill also has many animals that require daily medications for everything from diabetes to arthritis. Many of the senior residents need more medical interventions as they age. ### ASPCA Cool Pets on Hot Days

When the temperature goes up, leave your pet at home!



Leaving your pet in a hot car for even a short period of time can be very dangerous. Even with all windows cracked, the temperature of a car's interior can quickly rise to deadly levels.

Pets do not sweat the way we do; they cannot cool their bodies efficiently in hot temperatures. When overheated, pets can go into shock, leading to irreversible organ failure and death.

- Car temperatures can be more than 40 degrees higher than outside
- When it's 80 outside, the car temp can rise to 99 in just 10 minutes
- At that same external temp, the car gets to 109 in 20 minutes and 114 within a half-hour

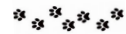
