It requires a minimum of 300 hours experience in dog training and passing a rigorous national exam that demonstrates knowledge and proficiency in current scientific evidence of canine behavior, development, training and much, much more.

Recently, Michele also became a licensed Family Paws Educator! This means she has knowledge to share with families with dogs who are expecting a baby or who have a toddler. Michele can give them advice and real-life strategies on how to prepare families with dogs for life with a baby and how to safely navigate the changes that will occur as the baby grows to a toddler.



Hallie Hill has many special needs dogs that are at the sanctuary because their previous owner did not understand their behaviors and needs. As our adoption counselor, Michele counsels adopters prior to, during, and after each adoption to increase the rate of success for the placement of the dog. She strives to reduce stress for both the family and the dog, so everyone feels good about the new family dynamics. We are fortunate, and so proud to have Michele as a part of the Hallie Hill team!

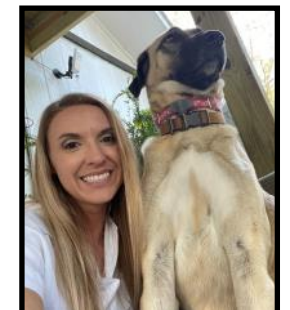

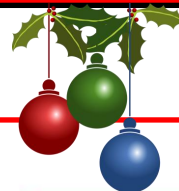

THE CAT CORNER



A cat's perception of its world

Hearing

- Broad range, superior to ours and dogs
- Movable, large ears to help localise, amplify and identify sounds
- Aids prey location and quick identification of territory intruders

Smell

- 1000 times more sensitive than our nose
- Experience odours more acutely than us

Vision

- Specialised for detecting movement and seeing in low light conditions when prey are most active
- Large, slightly protruding eyes provide a wide field of vision
- Excellent peripheral vision
- Lacking ability to see much in the red tones
- Short-range vision (<2m) is poor

Vibrissae (whiskers)

- Highly sensitive (base of each whisker packed with nerve endings)
- Used for spatial orientation and detecting air pressure and currents

Taste

- Poor sense of taste compared to us (approx. 470 taste buds compared to humans 9000)
- Excellent ability to smell enhances tongue's poor sense of taste
- Lacking ability to detect sweet taste

Vomerolnasal organ

- Chemical detection of pheromones
- Aids communication between cats
- Pheromones transmit information about territory, individual identity, reproductive state and potentially group cohesion

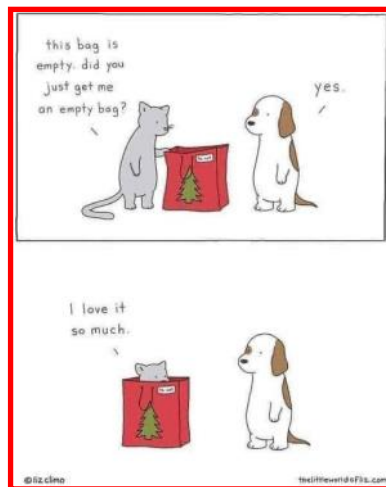
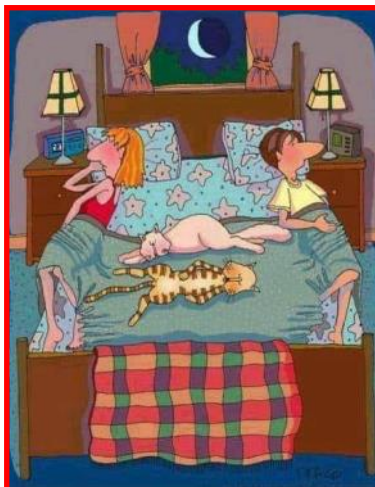
Touch

- Paw pads sensitive to touch and pressure
- Used to investigate objects in reach (eg, toys)
- Can detect vibrations such as footsteps

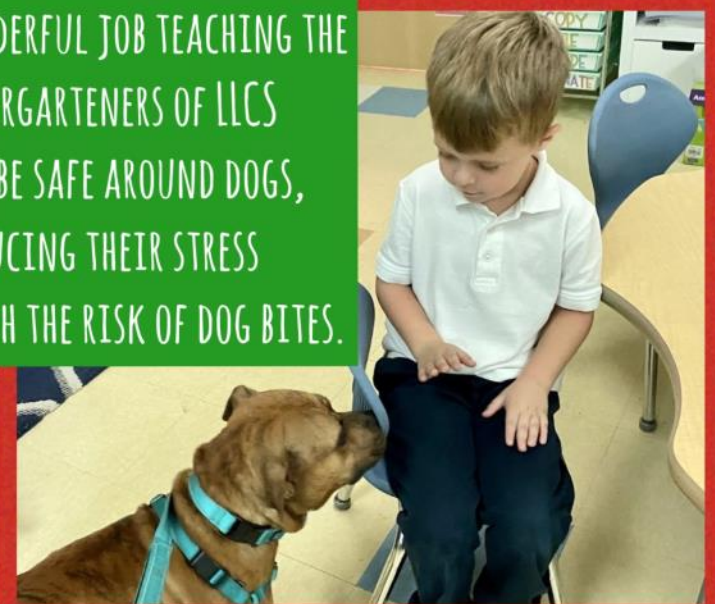
