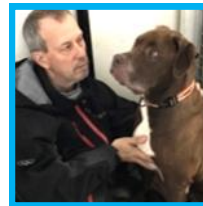

FORAGING 101

Cats are cute, but they're also stealthy predators, born to hunt and kill. Food puzzles (a.k.a. foraging toys) offer many benefits and are the closest thing to hunting we can offer our house cats. Here's how to start foraging and bring out your little predator's instincts!



Why Forage?

Foraging:

- Offers mental and physical stimulation by mimicking hunting
- Provides environmental enrichment
- Controls overeating
- Allows cats to control their most vital resource: food
- Relieves stress, boredom, and frustration (the leading causes of behavior problems)

Food Facts

Cats will rarely work for food that has been readily available for free (would you?). The key to food puzzles is to use novel food and/or treats to drive interest.



Once your cat has become accustomed to canned food, you can remove their bowl of dry and make it only available in toys. But NEVER starve your cat into a new food or behavior; it is dangerous and can cause liver problems.

Increasing the DIFFICULTY

If your cat has mastered the basics, it's time to gradually increase the challenge!

Decrease the **number of openings**.

Offer objects that **don't roll predictably**.



Use **opaque objects** that require cats to rely on their sense of smell and previous foraging experience.

Use **larger objects** with more weight.

Combine toys by taking smaller toys that they have mastered and putting them inside a larger toy. Yes, they really can get that good!

If you're using stationary toys, provide options with **more intricate moving parts**.



Foraging for BEGINNERS

The first toy should be easy! The goal is simply for them to learn the game and get rewarded for their behavior.



Start with clear objects so they can see, smell, and hear the kibble rattling around inside.

Round toys that roll easily are less frustrating.

While they're learning, toys should have multiple holes for kibble to dispense. Three holes is great for almost all beginners.

When you first place the toys, sprinkle kibble around them so your cats approach and hopefully start to push the object for more.

Still having trouble? Sprinkle kibble in some favorite napping or perch areas for them to discover during the day or leaving rolling toys open until your cat gets the hang of them.

If you have multiple cats, offer puzzles throughout your home. Cats hunt and eat alone, so feeding them in close proximity can create stressful competition that results in aggression.

Stationary foraging toys, which require cats to reach into an object to extract kibble are also great beginner toys. You can even make your own stationary puzzle out of an old ice cube tray, egg carton, or shoebox with holes cut into the top and sides.



Master foragers can use cubes, small toys stuffed inside of larger ones, puzzles hidden around the house, and stationary objects that require more self-control and skill, like pulling a string to open drawers!

The ultimate goal is to use the most difficult toy that your cat can learn. Do not have unrealistic expectations or be disappointed. Just like us, cats all have different skills.

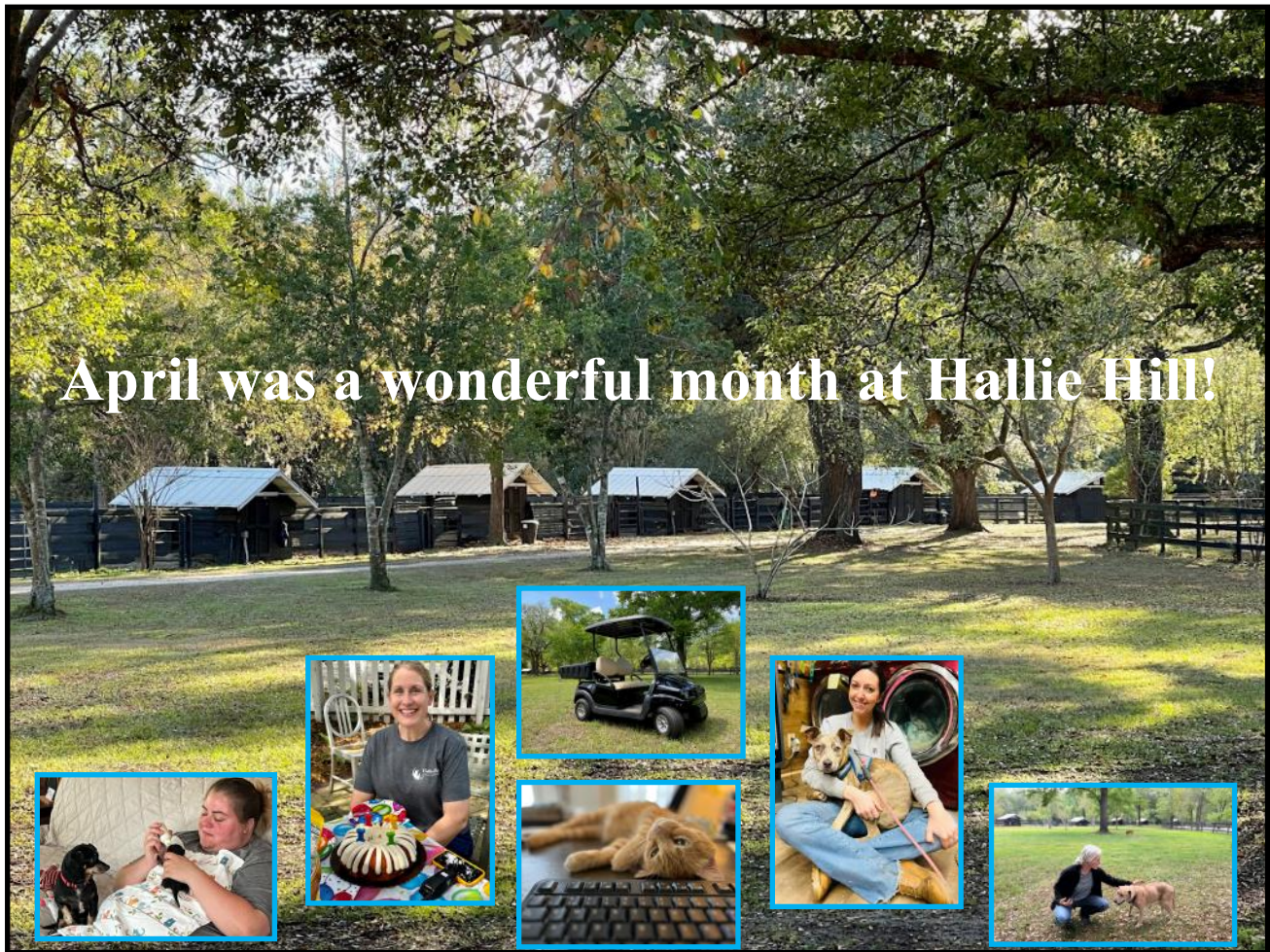
Liza
