

### GIFT OF THE GROWI



### DOGS DON'T BITE IF A GROWL WILL SUFFICE

A GROWL IS VERY VALUABLE COMMUNICATION THAT WE **NEED TO PAY ATTENTION TO** 

Growls should never be punished and never be ignored

Growls mean a dog feels -

- threatened / trapped
- afraid / anxious / stressed
- uncomfortable
- please stop what you're doing
- leave me alone / I need space

Growls are an early warning signal that we need to respect, understand & acknowledge

Dogs Disclosed

Growls provide a non violent warning in lieu of a bite

Punishing or ignoring the communication of a growl may encourage a dog to bite without warning

because we are not listening / understanding

"Growling isn't working to make it stop so I'll have to resort to a bite next time"



### Dogs generally only naturally sit to observe / to rest /

restrict genital access

### QUITTING SO MUCH SITTING

IS IT REALLY NECESSARY TO EXPECT DOGS TO "SIT!" SO MUCH?

Sitting may be uncomfortable or painful for growing dogs, senior dogs, certain breeds, large dogs, bone structure or medical conditions

calmness or impulse control

Sitting does not It may temporarily stop dogs from magically create moving, but it doesn't stop the underlying emotion - excitement / frustration / fear / anxiety

Dogs naturally stand in anticipation of food/ toys / games / chase / perceived threats

Non-fearful dogs stand to approach or greet

Expecting dogs to sit for duration suppresses natural behavior

Asking a fearful / reactive / unconfident dog to "sit" in the presence of a trigger will only intensify these emotions

Work with, not against a dog's natural behaviour instead of just focussing on "sit!"

Wait / stand / 4 feet on the ground / hand touch / chin rest are some alternatives

The belief that only a sit can = good manners / obedience / calm / self control / is incompatible with unwanted behaviour needs to change






