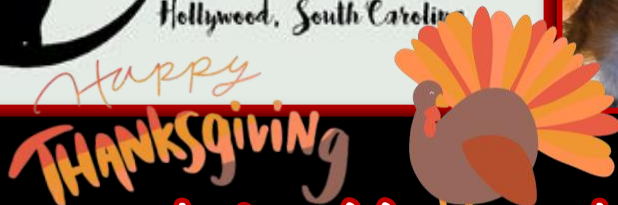

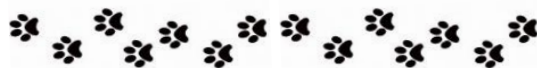


Volunteer Spotlight

Volunteer openings on the weekend are full, but morning opportunities are currently available on several weekdays.

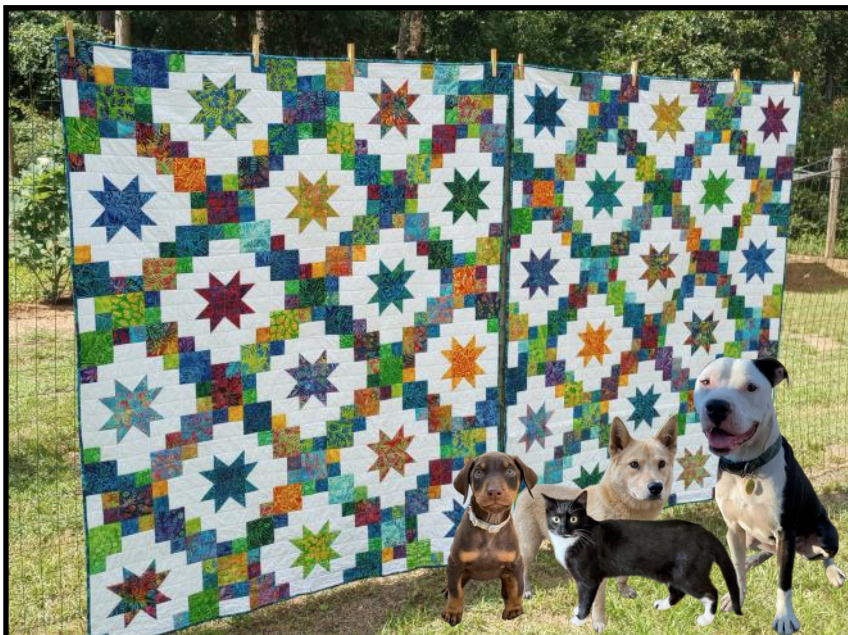

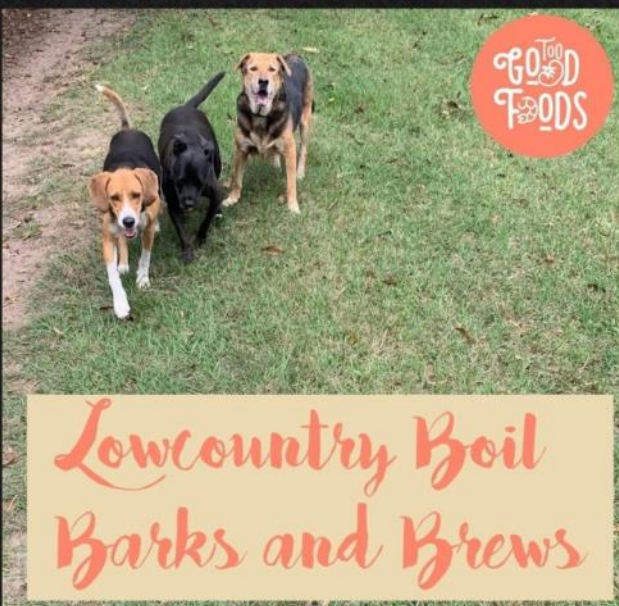
- X SAGE** and other herbs and essential oils can cause stomach upset and other complications.
- X ONIONS** can lead to a threatening form of anemia which can go undetected until it's too late.
- X COOKED BONES** are brittle and fragments can lodge themselves in a dog's intestines.
- X SKIN** fat content and added oils and seasonings make it a bad choice for your pup.
- X GRAVY** fatty foods and trimmings are known to cause pancreatitis in dogs.

SHARE

- ✓ CRANBERRIES** in small amounts, less sugary cranberry concoctions serve up vitamin C and antioxidants.
- ✓ TURKEY** however, only in treat-sized portions. Also, make sure the turkey contains no bones, and white meat is better.
- ✓ PUMPKIN** plain cooked or canned pumpkin is a sweet treat, but don't feed your dogs pumpkin pie filling!
- ✓ PLAIN MASHED POTATOES** unless your recipe is full of butter and seasons, plain mashed taters are a treat.
- ✓ YAMS** Plain yams are rich and full of fiber, which is good for dogs.

THE CAT CORNER

New Cat

Congratulations on getting a cat!
To give your cat a happy start in their new home, here are some tips.

Offer hiding spaces
Provide a mix of high and low hiding spaces. Make sure these spaces are small but not too small, and in a place where your cat has a good view of the rest of room. A hiding space could be as simple as a cardboard box, or you could buy a cat cave or cat condo.

Provide the basics
Food, water, two litter boxes, scratching post, bed, and toys.

Develop a routine
Set aside consistent times for meals, play, and other activities, including just spending time with them.

Don't forget grooming!
Regularly brush your cat's fur and teeth and trim its claws.

Provide a safe space
Start your new cat in a small room. Along with the basic necessities, include some of your unwashed clothes so your cat can get used to your scent. When your cat is ready, let it explore one new room at a time.

The MAGIC Fund is used to cover the many medical costs that arise at the sanctuary. New arrivals require vaccinations and spay/neuter surgeries. All of the 200 animals receive monthly heart worm and flea preventative. Many animals develop orthopedic or other health problems that require surgery. Hallie Hill also has many animals that require daily medications for everything from diabetes to arthritis. Many of the senior residents need more medical interventions as they age. 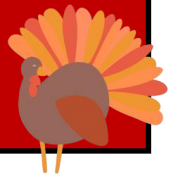
