



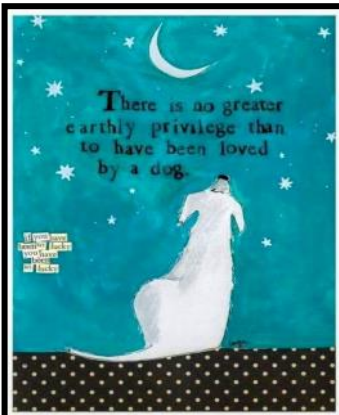

PROVIDING SANCTUARY

PROVIDING NOURISHMENT
Apportioned over 40,150 pounds of dog food and over 5475 pounds of cat food for animals onsite.

SENIOR CARE
Administered loving care to 144 senior animals with special needs associated with their advanced years.

SAFE HAVEN FOR STRAYS
Cared for 36 animals brought in by the public as strays.

BARN CAT SANCTUARY
Provided an onsite safe-haven for over 30 community cats.

SERVING THE COMMUNITY

PET ADOPTIONS
Placed 111 animals into loving homes while offering pre and post adoption counseling and resources to help make placements successful.

DISEASE & PARASITE PREVENTION
Administered vaccinations to 377 animals preventing deadly diseases like rabies and administered heartworm and flea prevention to 377 animals.

END OF LIFE CARE
Provided respectful and loving care to help transition 21 animals through the end-of-life process.

EDUCATION
Presented educational pieces on 4 television stations. Educated elementary, middle, and high school students covering topics ranging from dog bite prevention to community service.

HELPING FAMILIES
Accepted animals at no charge from 62 families unable to keep their pets.

COMMUNITY EVENTS & OUTREACH
Attended 28 community events and supplied food for over 63 offsite community cats.

ASSISTING SHELTERS
Accepted 41 animals from overcrowded local shelters.

VOLUNTEER INVOLVEMENT
Partnered with businesses, private individuals and schools who donated over 6918 hours of time.

DON'T GET A DOG ...

UNLESS YOU MAKE A COMMITMENT

DOGS ARE NOT PROPERTY, SECURITY GUARDS, DECORATIONS, ACCESSORIES, TOYS, KIDS ENTERTAINMENT, COMMODITIES, A WAY TO MAKE MONEY



Do you have the time / patience / commitment / understanding / resources

Dogs need attention, social interaction, companionship, physical & mental stimulation

Dogs are sentient beings with emotional needs

Dogs are social beings - needing social contact

Inconsistent schedule / away for long hours while your dog is left alone?

Dogs need consistency, routine / predictable patterns to feel safe & secure

Researched the breed? Different breeds have natural / genetic behaviours & needs that must be understood & taken into account

Understand that what may look like a problem behaviour is often just a dog behaving normally?

Understand that just like us, dogs have different levels of sociability & tolerance? Your dog may not be the socialite you envisaged

Understand that dogs are a long term commitment - ± 12 to 15 years

Prepared to make the effort & take time to learn modern, science based methods to train your dog / modify any unwanted behaviour?

Don't like dirty floors, dog hair, slobbered on or having your garden redesigned?

Don't get a dog if you can't make a commitment to meeting their needs / sharing your time & life with them

DOGS MIGHT LOOK GUILTY BUT THEY'RE NOT FEELING GUILTY

DO DOGS KNOW WHEN THEY'VE DONE WRONG & FEEL GUILTY OR ASHAMED ?



THE LOOK VS THE FEELING

That guilty look is a response to our tone of voice / body language

Dogs are experts at reading body language / tone & know when we're not happy with them

EMOTIONS Although dogs experience many emotions, their emotionality is similar to +/- a 2 1/2 year old child

It's unlikely that higher levels of emotions, like guilt / shame / regret / remorse are felt

THAT GUILTY LOOK IS FEAR / STRESS

The body language of fear / stress / appeasement may look like "guilt" -

- Tail tucked under
- Avoiding eye contact
- Flattened ears
- Cowering
- Hunched posture
- Turning away

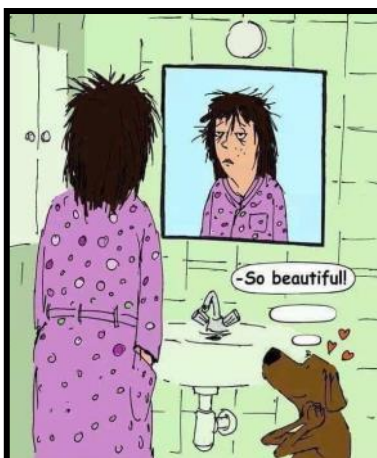
These are signs of fear / stress / appeasement - a dogs attempt to calm us down

REACTION A dogs reaction is based on their learning history / associations / our body language, tone / pitch - *Dogs Disclosed*
