On April 10th, Hallie Hill hosted its second monthly surgery and clinic, partnering again with PETSinc to provide low-cost veterinary services. In April, there were 25 surgeries for spay and neuter and 23 well checks. Hallie Hill Executive Director Jennifer Middleton said she hopes the events continue to grow. “We are so excited to be able to put our new medical clinic to use. Offering low-cost veterinary services is a great way to make sure our medical clinic is serving a key role in animal welfare in the area,” she said. The next clinic will be Thursday, May 8th. Surgeries are by appointment only, please follow link on the next page to schedule! Wellness checkups do not require an appointment and are offered on a first come, first served basis.

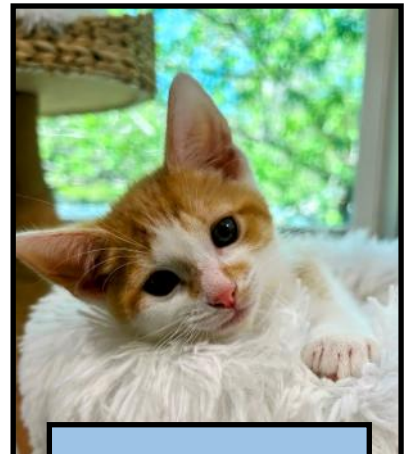

New Cat

Congratulations on getting a cat!

To give your cat a happy start in their new home, here are some tips.



Develop a routine
Set aside consistent times for meals, play, and other activities, including just spending time with them.

Offer hiding spaces
Provide a mix of high and low hiding spaces. Make sure these spaces are small but not too small, and in a place where your cat has a good view of the rest of room. A hiding space could be as simple as a cardboard box, or you could buy a cat cave or cat condo.



Don't forget grooming!
Regularly brush your cat's fur and teeth and trim its claws.



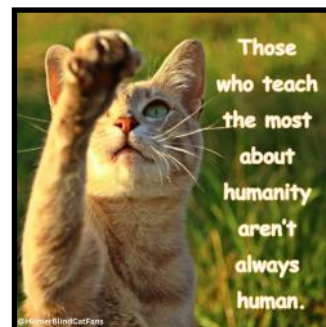
Provide the basics
Food, water, two litter boxes, scratching post, bed, and toys.



Provide a safe space
Start your new cat in a small room. Along with the basic necessities, include some of your unwashed clothes so your cat can get used to your scent. When your cat is ready, let it explore one new room at a time.

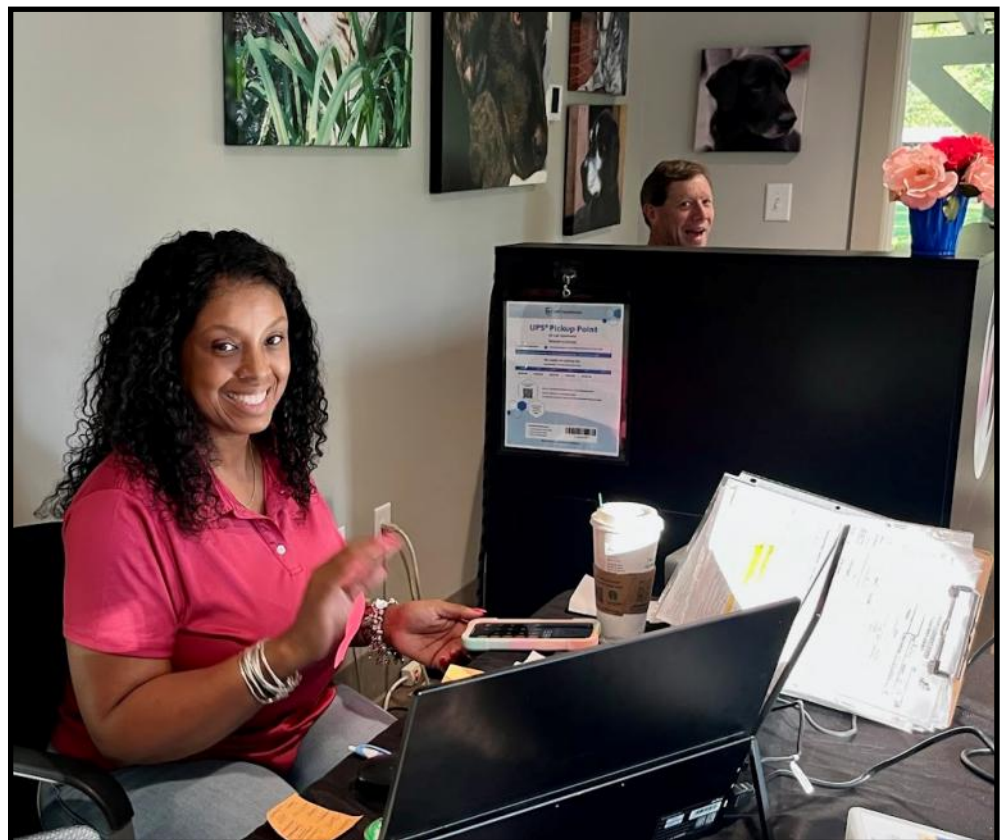
What We Need

 Sponsored Centrifuge (spins blood, urine and fecal samples to separate their components for testing) - \$1,000	 Sponsored Countertop autoclave (sterilizes medical equipment for surgeries) - \$7,500	 Sponsored Anesthesia machines (to safely place animals under anesthesia to perform necessary procedures such as dental cleanings and spays/neuters) (2) - \$3,000 each
 Sponsored Oxygen concentrators (Necessary to provide oxygen to animals during anesthetic procedures) - \$3,000	 Sponsored Pulse oximeters (Monitors a patient's blood pressure, oxygenation, and heart rate during anesthesia or a medical emergency) - \$750	 Sponsored Microscope (used to examine blood, feces, tumor/skin cells etc on a microscopic level to better diagnose and treat animals) - \$1,000
 Sponsored Blood analyzer (Allows on-site diagnosis of many chronic and medical conditions, as well as anesthetic safety). - \$3,500	 Sponsored Dental scaler and polisher (Ultrasonic cleaning and polishing of the patient's teeth. Source of disease for dogs and cats, and onsite would allow many more of our residents to receive this care.) - \$2,000

Make Your Own AGILITY FUN!

1. Hurdles (Jumps)

What you'll need: Broomsticks, pool noodles, mop handles, or PVC pipe + two objects to prop them up (like buckets, flower pots, or cardboard boxes with holes cut in them).



How to make it: Rest the stick across your props at a low height your dog can easily step over. Increase the height slightly as your dog gets more confident.

2. Hoop Jump.

What you'll need: A hula hoop or a sturdy ring-shaped item.

How to make it: Hold it just above the ground and encourage your dog to walk through it. Slowly raise it a few inches as they get the hang of it. Always keep it low enough to avoid injury.



3. Tunnel

What you'll need: A collapsible kids' play tunnel, cardboard boxes taped together, or large fabric laundry baskets with the bottoms cut out.

How to make it: Create a low, safe tunnel your dog can crawl through. Use treats or toys to lure them through and praise big when they come out the other side!



4. Weave Poles

What you'll need: Tall garden stakes, plastic cups, empty pop bottles, or sticks.

How to make it: Line up 6-8 items in a straight line about 2 feet apart. Stick them into the ground (or tape them to the floor indoors). Encourage your dog to weave between them slowly at first using treats or toys as a guide.

Teach Your Dog To SEARCH!

1. Ask your dog to "Sit", "Down" or "Place", or restrain them using a tied leash/crate/gate.



2. Put a treat a distance away, but where your dog can see it.



3. Tell your dog to "Search" and let them go eat the treat.



4. Reset your dog and repeat steps 1-3 again, but put the treat in different spots each time.



5. Hide the treat just around the corner, where they can't directly see it.

6. Tell your dog to "Search" and let them find and eat the treat.

7. Repeat steps 5-7 a few times, but put the treat in different spots each time.

8. Start hiding the treats in more difficult places, but not too difficult until your dog really gets the hang of it. Hide more than one at once so you don't have to reset your dog in a "Stay"/restraint each time.

Eventually they will start using their nose instead of their eyes to find the treats (so be sure to use smelly treats!). Once your dog starts using their nose, they will be exhausted after about 10-20 minutes of playing.

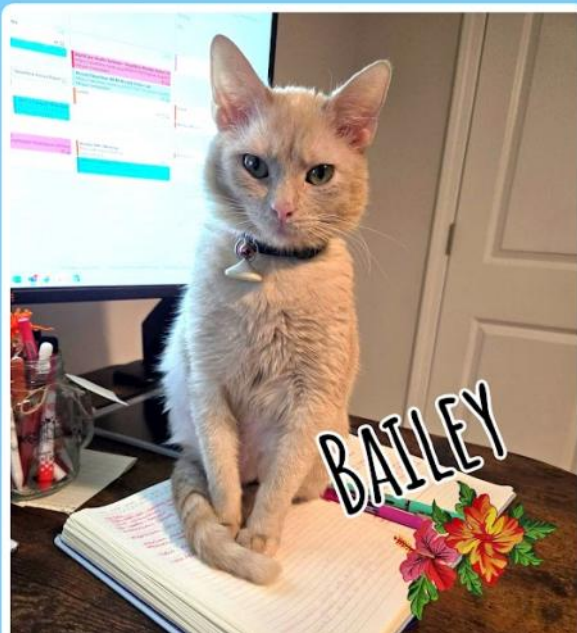

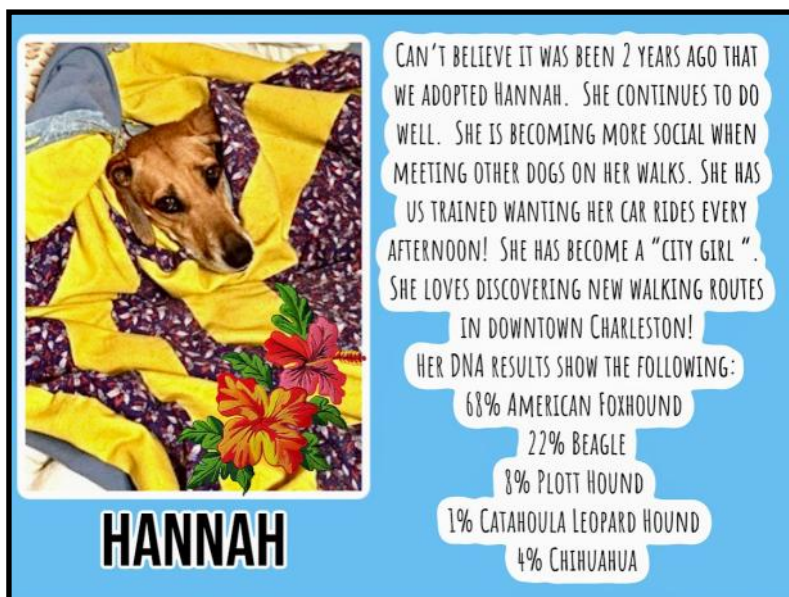
