### **Knuckles: A Senior Fighter with a Big Heart**

Knuckles, a sweet senior bulldog mix, came to Hallie Hill as a senior in late 2024 and developed a noticeable mass on his paw that was making it painful for him to walk. At his age, surgery can be risky—but not doing anything wasn't an option. With the help of the MAGIC Fund, Knuckles underwent surgery to have the mass removed. He is now recovering comfortably and already showing more energy and mobility than we've seen in a long time.



### **Taz: A Tiny Pup Finding Comfort**

Taz, a timid senior chihuahua mix, has battled eye issues for years. It was determined that removal was the best option to ensure his comfort and prevent further complications. Thanks to contributions to the MAGIC Fund, Taz had the surgery and is now enjoying life without pain—still sweet and shy, and still stealing hearts.

# Volunteer Corner

## Six Months at \*The Hub\* - And Growing!

It's hard to believe we've already been in our new facility, The Hub, for six months! This move has brought exciting changes, allowing us to serve more animals and people in our community than ever before. With the additional space, we've been able to expand our services in ways that were never possible before-and we're eagerly anticipating the opening of our new cattery soon! (see page 12)



As the sanctuary grows, so does our volunteer program. Hallie Hill is a one-of-a-kind place, offering a unique experience for our volunteers. Our opportunities are unlike those at a traditional shelter, and we welcome your input, ideas, and expertise to help make things even better.



This month, we're highlighting one of our newest volunteer opportunities: the Turf Team! Our dogs live in large grassy enclosures rather than traditional kennels. With sixty-seven pens, many larger than the typical Lowcountry backyard, there's a lot of ground to cover, literally! Maintaining these spaces is a big job. Most of the mowing is done by Daisy, one of our talented Animal Care Technicians, who has developed a smooth, efficient system. To support her efforts, we created the Turf Team - a great opportunity for Tier 2 and 3 volunteers trained to enter dog enclosures. Turf Team volunteers help by entering the pens to collect toys, moving feeding crates off the grass, gently guiding the dogs away from the gate so Daisy can safely enter and exit with the mower and spending quality time with the dogs while mowing is in progress. This opportunity is scheduled in the afternoons on specific days, and it's a rewarding way to help ensure the dogs have a clean, safe, and enjoyable environment. Interested? 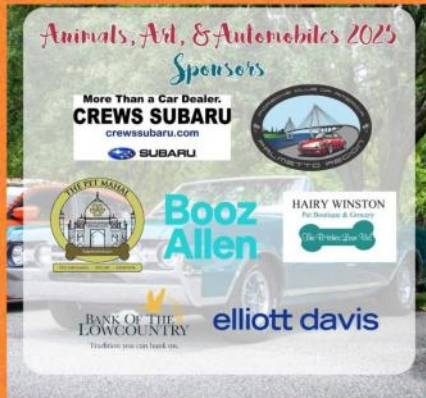

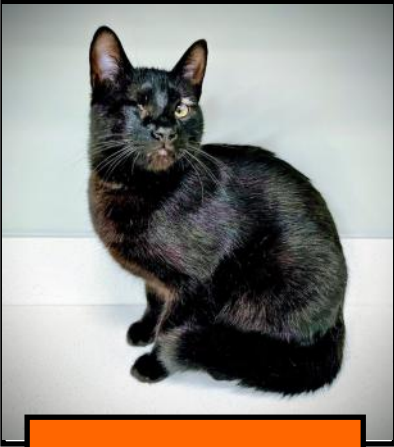

## THE CAT CORNER



### A FEW FACTS ABOUT YOUR CAT'S WHISKERS

Whiskers are thicker than normal hair. They're really touch receptors rooted more deeply and rich in nerve endings.



Whiskers can detect changes in air currents. This helps cats navigate in darkness to avoid bumping into objects. This ability also helps when hunting to detect swift movements of nearby prey.



Most cats have 12 muzzle whiskers on each side of the cheek, divided into four rows for most accurate navigation.



When cats capture prey under their paws, the carpal whiskers, located at the back of the forelegs, help determine prey position and movement. Cats are far-sighted so this up-close assistance is important to accurately deliver a killing bite.



Whiskers above the eyes help in tall grass or bushy areas to avoid injury by triggering protective eye blinks when near branches or brush.



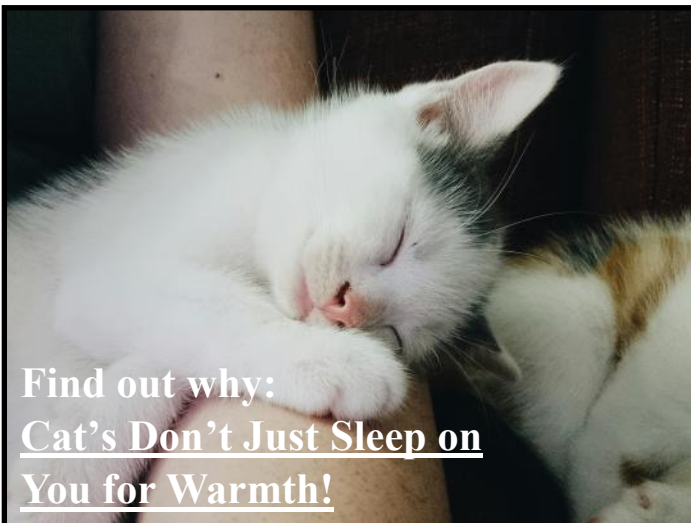
Because whiskers are so highly sensitive, they should never be cut, pulled or bent.



Muzzle whiskers help cats determine whether they can fit through small openings. Muzzle whiskers are about as long as body width. If they can fit through an opening without bending then the cat should be able to squeeze through. This theory may not work if a cat becomes overweight.

### How to play with a cat?

**Create a fun environment**  
Cardboard boxes and paper bags always capture a cat's attention. To create a more interesting and challenging game, move the toy behind them or under door gaps, rugs or blankets.

**Observe your cat's behavior**  
If it's getting intense or angry, stop playing. If it walks away, take a break. Like anything, moderation is key and each feline personality is different. Go at your cat's pace and tailor the games to its abilities and limitations—especially with older cats.

**Don't use your hands**  
Using your fingers, hands or other body parts teaches cats that the human body is alright to bite. And, according to cat logic, if it's okay to bite your toes when you wiggle them on the sofa, then it's perfectly fine to bite them when you're sleeping.

**Let your cat win**  
Ease off the play sessions by making the toy move less and less (like a wounded animal), and let your pet catch and "kill" it. Usually cats catch the toy with their front paws and then start biting and kicking it with their back feet.

### How to pick cat toys?

- 1 The same qualities that entice cats to hunt also get them to play.
- 2 So pick toys that look like prey—like a bug, a bird or a mouse.

**How to play without toys?**  
Empty cardboard boxes, paper bags, toilet-roll tubes, feathers, hair ties, ribbons and bottle caps are all feline favorites.

### How to play with a kitten?

- 1 Kittens love to hide, chase, pounce and climb, so incorporate any of these activities.
- 2 Don't leave your kitty alone with toys that could be shredded and eaten.

**How to play with an older cat?**  
1 Don't wait for an invitation - senior cats are more relaxed and might not initiate a game.

### Cat Fact: Cats have a "catnip gene."

Not all cats are affected by catnip—it's estimated that about 30% of cats lack the genetic sensitivity to its active compound, nepetalactone. For those that do have the "catnip gene," though, the herb can cause a temporary euphoria, rolling, sniffing, and playful behavior that lasts for about 10 minutes. It's like their version of a spa day!



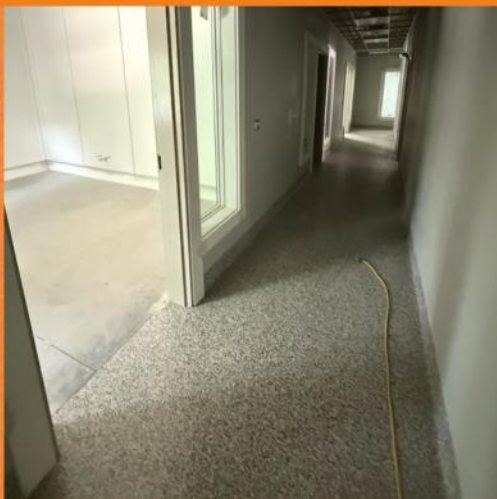

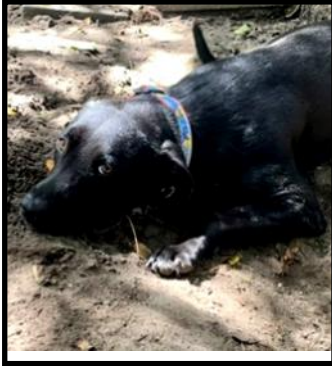

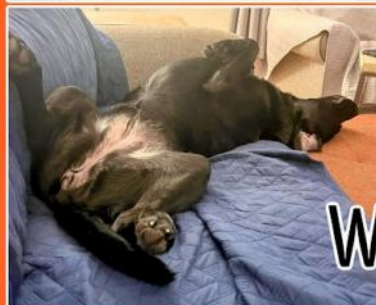
